A motion was made to accept the recommendation for the proposed increase by the Committee- Ray Mott, seconded by Dick Faircloth, the motion was voted on and passed.

Gate Lock Combination - The Gate lock combination was given to all that were present. It will be changed in the next day or so. The new combination will only be given to those that have renewed.

The FAA issued the NPRM for amending its regulations to adopt specific rules to allow the operation of small unmanned aircraft systems in the National Airspace System. These changes would address the operation of unmanned aircraft systems, certification of their operators, registration, and display of registration markings. The proposed rule would also find that airworthiness certification is not required for small unmanned aircraft system operations that would be subject to this proposed rule. Lastly, the proposed rule would prohibit model aircraft from endangering the safety of the National Airspace System.

Instructions for sending comments are included in the proposed rulemaking. It is attached for your review.

New Business: The Dues committee also recommended a standing dues/membership committee be established to work on retaining and growing membership. This was tabled to next meeting

A senate bill SB 370 was introduced in the Maryland State Legislation session that pertains to unmanned aircraft. Here is a summary of the bill and the full information on the bill can be found at the following website:

Summary SB370 - Providing that only the State may enact a law or take other action to prohibit, restrict, or regulate the testing or operation of unmanned aircraft systems; preempting specified county and municipal authority and providing that specified laws or ordinances are superseded; specifying that federal preemption is not affected by the Act; requiring the Department of Business and Economic Development, in consultation with the University of Maryland and other interested parties, to study specified benefits; etc.
